



This notice is required by the CARES Act and Oregon Employment Department to be provided to employees upon termination.

Notification to Employees of Availability of Unemployment Compensation

Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits are available to workers who are unemployed and who meet the requirements of Oregon unemployment eligibility laws. You may file a UI claim in the first week that employment stops, or work hours are reduced. Employees may file claims online or by telephone, as specified below.

You will need to provide the Employment Department with the following information in order for the state to process your claim:

- Your Social Security Number.
- Your work history for the last 18 months, including dates of employment, your employer's business names, addresses and phone numbers.
- Your salary and total income (for at least the last year) from each employer.
- If you are not a citizen of the United States, you will need your Alien Registration Number and documentation.
- Phone number where you can be reached during normal business hours.
